

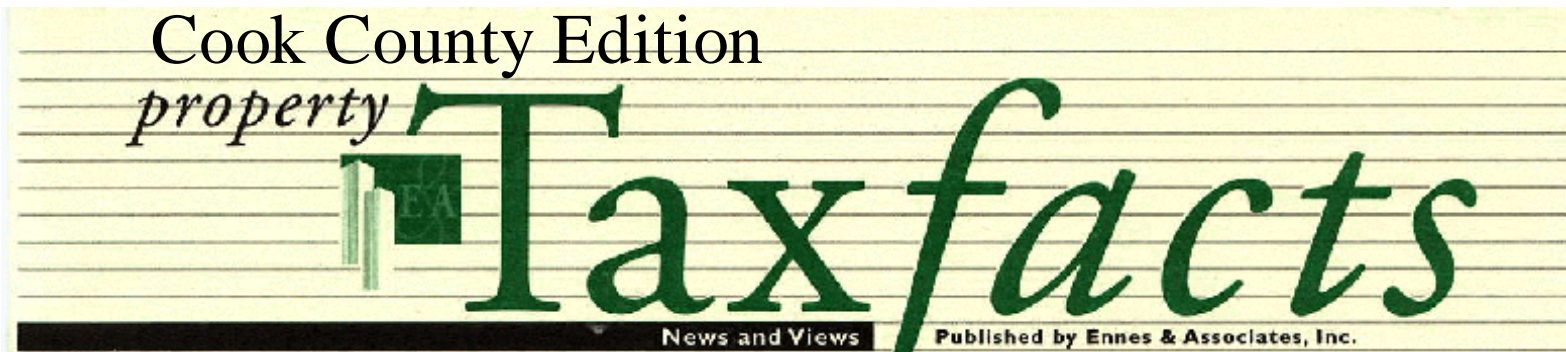
Heading South!!

Didn't pay your Cook County tax bill by March 1??

Don't Worry!!



Remember this year the Illinois Legislature gave us one extra month to pay our property tax bills. The bills, which reflect 55% of last year's total tax bill, came out in early February and are due April 1. If you miss the April 1 deadline however, a 1.5 percent penalty will be levied. It is expected the first installment payment deadline will revert back to March 1 in 2012.

You can pay them by mail, electronically at cookcountytreasurer.com, at a Chase Bank location or from personal accounts at 208 participating community banks.

Just an FYI...if E&A successfully appealed your 2010 assessment this year you will see the reduction reflected on your 2nd installment property tax bill due out later this year.
